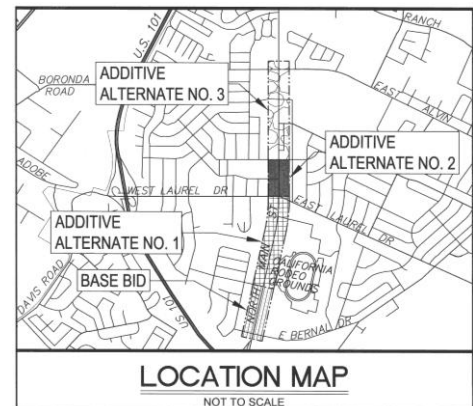
### North Main Street Improvements (Between Bernal Drive and Alvin Drive), C.I.P. Project No. 9282

#### Description

The Project calls for street rehabilitation, two inches (2") asphalt pavement overlay; minor traffic signal modifications; new ADA- compliant access ramps at curb returns; construction of new raised median islands with landscaping, trees, landscape lighting, and irrigation; street trees within sidewalk; installation of new energy efficient (LED) street lighting; signing; striping; and new gateway monument sign.

The Project cost is \$ 2.6 million.
