Project Status Update

Week of March 22 - 26 and Looking Ahead for the Weeks of March 29 - April 16

The Bardin Road Safe Routes to School Project - "Complete Streets" improvements are intended to provide safe mobility for all users (pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists). The goal of this project is to ensure that travelers of all ages and abilities can move safely and efficiently along, across, to and from Bardin Road, including Bardin Elementary and other schools in the area. The project focuses on improving routes to school to create safer streets that improve active travel to and from schools for parents, children, and the general public.

Description of Work: The work includes roadway reconstruction, pavement maintenance, construction of curb and gutter, sidewalks, pedestrian access ramps, drainage improvements, street lighting, utility trenching, replacement of sewer and water mains, landscape and irrigation improvements and signage and street markings. These improvements are divided into four separate schedules as follows:

- **Schedule A** includes the items above for the construction of two roundabouts, one at East Alisal Street and Bardin Road, and one at Alisal Road and Sconberg Parkway, and construction of a school drop off zone for Bardin Elementary School.
- **Schedule B** includes the items above for the construction of multiple bulb-outs along Bardin Road and East Alisal Street and pavement rehabilitation.
- **Schedule C** includes the items above for the reconstruction of ADA curb ramps and pavement rehabilitation on Alisal Road, within the County's jurisdiction.
- **Schedule D** includes the replacement of portions of the sewer main in Bardin Road and East Alisal Street.

Activities During the Week of March 22 - 26: What's Being Accomplished?

SCHEDULE A

- Construction area signs.
- Silt fencing to reduce construction airborne dust.
- Stormwater pollution prevention measures.

There is no activity programmed for Schedules B, C, and D.

Upcoming Activity: What's Anticipated in the Next Two - Three Weeks?

SCHEDULE A

- Site grading on the south and west sides of Bardin Rd and Alisal Street to even out existing undeveloped surfaces in preparation for the new roadway configuration of the two roundabouts.

Road and Lane Closures: Traffic control signs and devices: **PAY ATTENTION TO TRAFFIC SIGNS**, follow the posted speed limit and be safe while driving through our construction work zones. Vehicular traffic will be impacted at the following streets:

- Alisal Street (south of Margaret Street to Bardin Road).
- Bardin Road (Alisal Street to Alisal Road).
- Alisal Road
